

Eddie's Police Scanner Feed

Several people have asked how I have my "Live Scanner Feed" setup. So below is a summary of my setup.

I'm using a dedicated server (PC) for the scanner server software, also using a Bearcat BC895XLT.

The server is running:

- **Windows 2000** is the operating system.
- **Icecast2** is the server software that clients will connect to in order to listen to your feed.
- **Simplecast** is the software that connects to Icecast and provides the audio (and alpha tags if you're using them).
- **Serproxy** provides the base connectivity between the server and the scanner.
- **Monitor** is a software interface that sends the Alpa Tags.
- **AVG free AntiVirus** is a anti-virus program

Scanner's audio output connects to the server soundcard (line-in jack).

A cable connects between the scanner's control port and comport 1 on the server.
